### Disfigurer of Wife in New York City Arrested in Baltimore.

Baltimore, Md., July 1.—After eluding the police of New York city for eight years, Nathan Zemon is now in the custody of Detective-Bergeant Leary, of that city. He was arrested here. He is charged with choking his wife and pouring acid over her face.

Zemon disappeared after the assault and went to Europe. He recently returned to this country.

New York, July 1.—Zemon's wife was Rosie Goldberg, a more than usually pretty woman, who lived at No 33 Clinton street, this city, before their marriage. Zemon, crippled up and weak from disease, constantly feared death was upon him and became jealous of his wife at the thought she would marry another after his death.

On the night of March 1, 1915, he told her he had received a telegram from her father, summoning them from Tonkara to New York. Arriving at the Grand Central Station, he took his wife to the viaduct crossing 43d street, and broke a bottle of acid over her head. She was found half an hour later by a policeman and taken to Flower hospital. Her face was badly disfigured by the acid.
